

Mobile partitions are a low cost, but effective way to divide neighboring programming areas from each other. Think about partitions that provide additional storage in your space, like mobile shelving units, partitions that double as writing surfaces, like mobile whiteboards, or even partitions made of glass, Plexiglas, or sound absorptive materials. Use a combination of modular lounge furniture and tables and chairs to create a comfortable informal space where patrons can browse reading materials, independently use technology, have conversations, or wait for an upcoming program. Furniture can be rearranged to accommodate large or small groups or even one-on-one conversations.
